What is “A Day with the Doctors?”

“A Day with the Doctors” is a one-day, interactive program that offers high school students with an interest in medicine, an opportunity to experience doctors’ daily activities and life on LSU Health Sciences Center’s campus.

Some of the activities students participate in include a presentation of basic pulmonary physiology, learning physical diagnosis skills, and development of a problem list based on an actual case study. Students will also be trained in diagnostic skills such as taking blood pressure, listening to heart sounds, taking a radial pulse, measuring respiratory rates and listening to breathing sounds.

Participants interact with medical students, learn how to apply to medical school, learn what it’s like to be a medical student, and are informed of the admission requirements for LSU Health Science Center in New Orleans.

Who can participate in “A Day with the Doctors?”

High school students currently enrolled as seniors and who have an interest in becoming a doctor may apply. Students must have a 3.0 grade point average.
